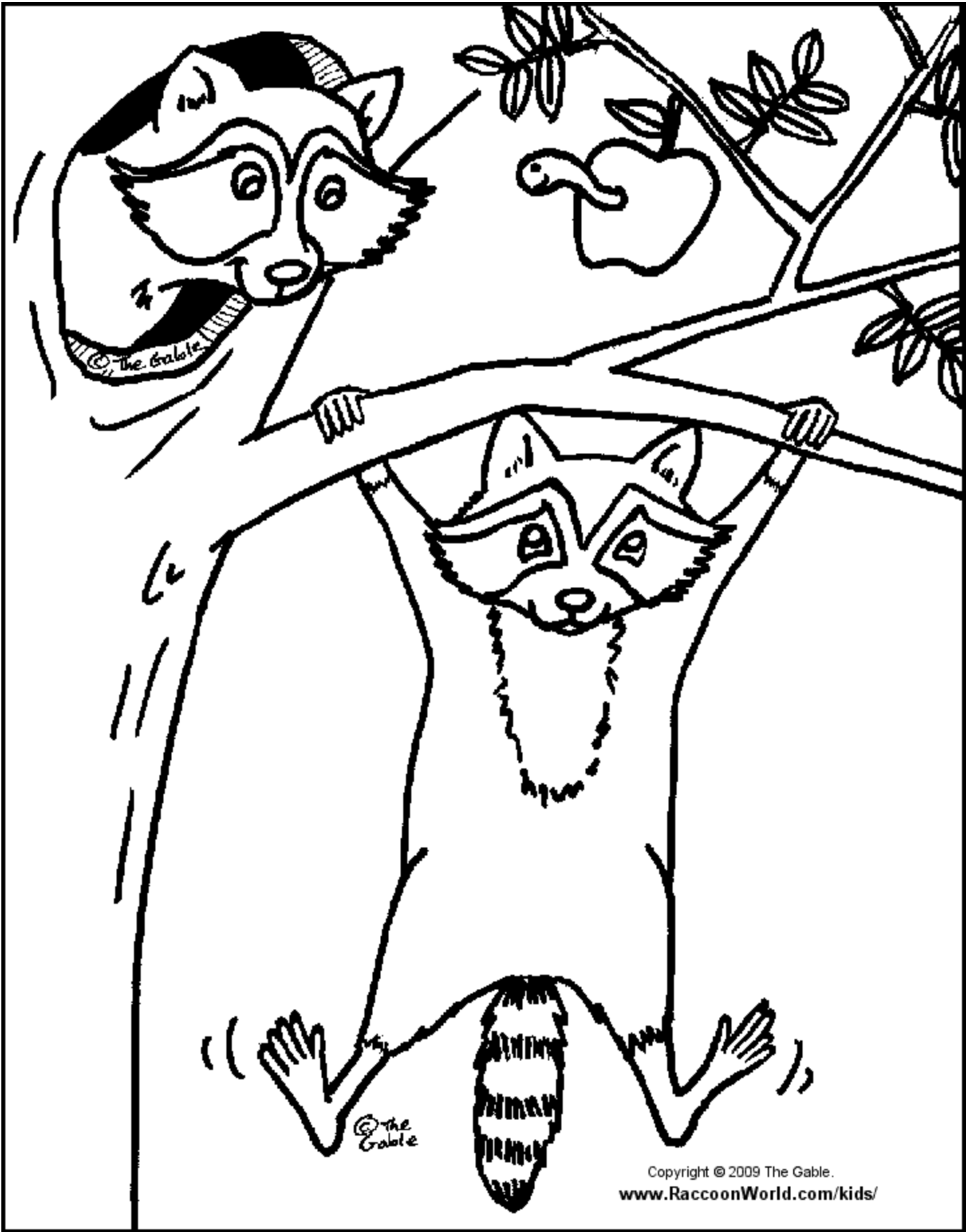


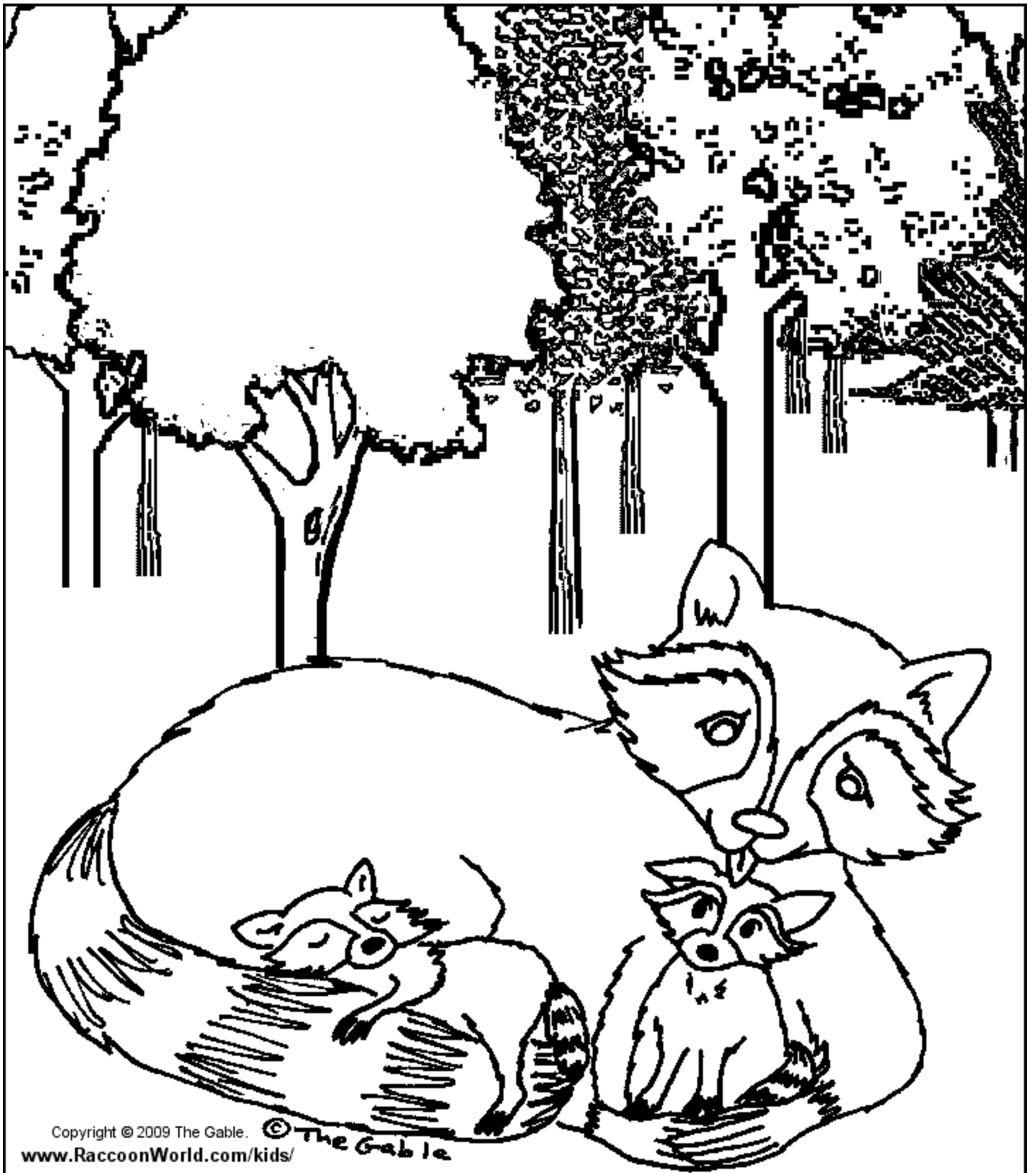


The Raccoon

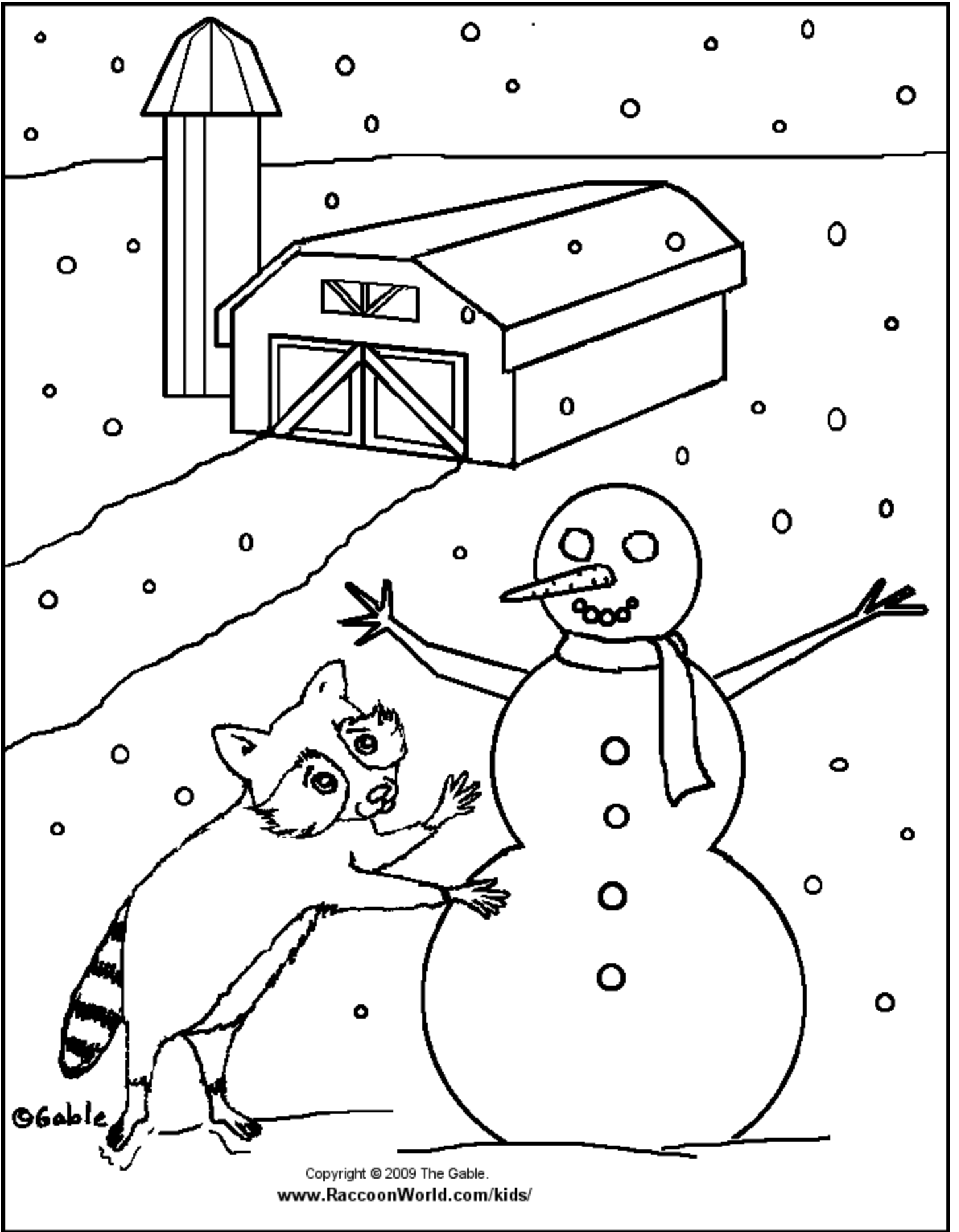

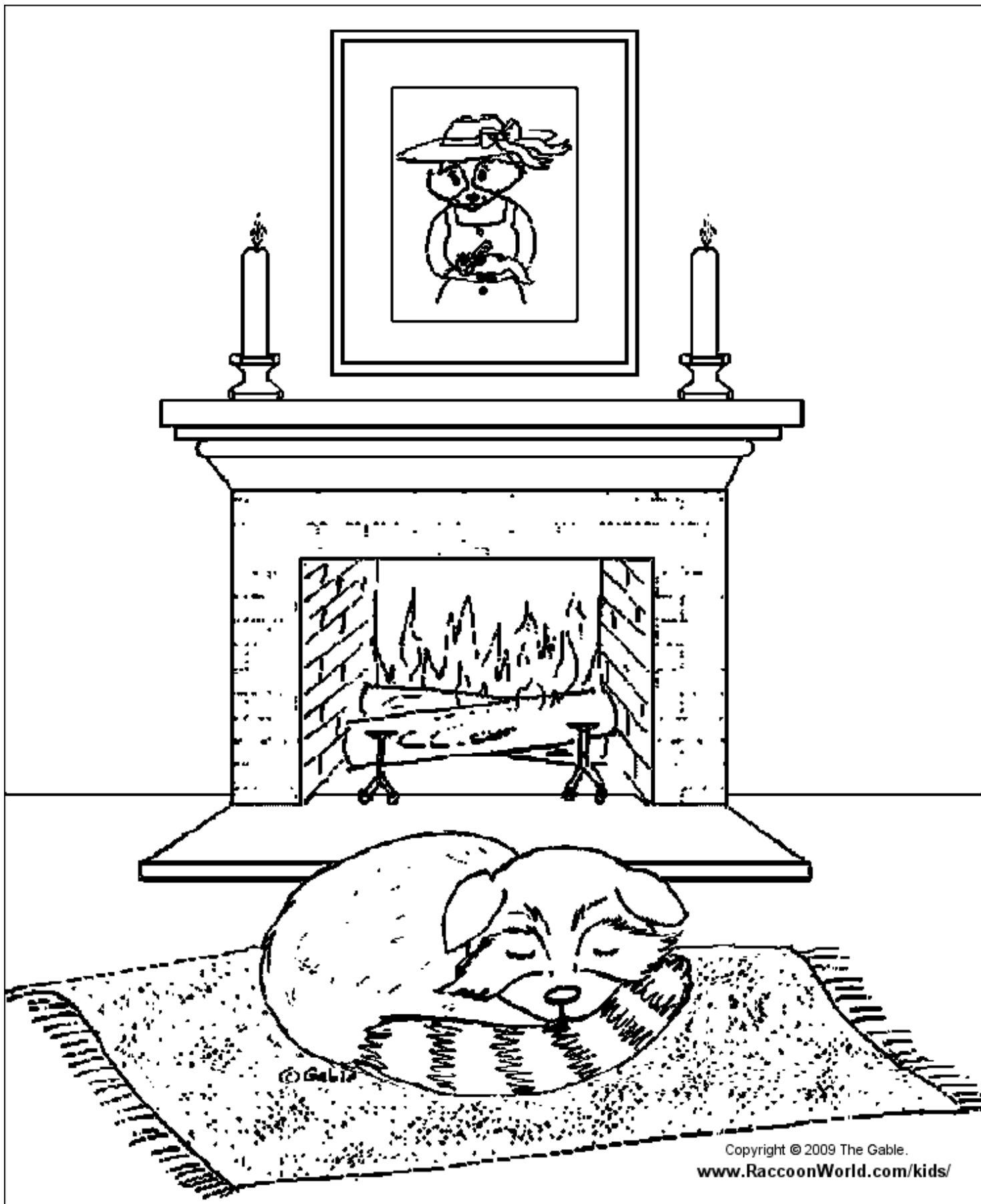
